## Supply List for Anthony Wayne Preschool

### Summer Camp

- **Book bag**- big enough for folder to fit inside
- **Folder with name clearly marked on the front**
- **Sunscreen**- This will be labeled and kept out of reach of children. We will apply sunscreen before going outside throughout the day.
- **Extra change of clothes** – This will be kept inside of their cubby. Please put in Ziploc or reusable bag with name on the front.
- **Washable markers**- classic colors preferred
- **Crayons**- 16 count pack is best for color recognition)
- **2 Glue Sticks**
- **Child size rounded scissors**- If your child is returning, we will use the same ones as last year
- **Bottle of white school glue**
- **Play Dough**- 4 regular size or 6 mini size
- **Package of Baby Wet Wipes**
- **Mask**- This will not be required to wear, but to keep in backpack or cubby for compliance with Covid-19 licensing requirements. Please label with child's name or initials.
- **Packed Lunch**- Drinks are not necessary, cold water will be provided during lunch.
- **Nap-time Items**- Small, light blankets recommended. Travel size pillow and a small stuffed animal/doll are also welcomed. Please no roll mats or bulky items as they do not fit in their cubby well.
- **Playground Shoes**- These will stay at school throughout the year. They can be boots or tennis shoes and can be switched out as the seasons change.
